

Work is underway on the two overpasses and two viaducts started in October 2014 within the scope of the Northern Marmara Highway being constructed by ICA İçtaş-Astaldi, Inc. Consortium. The manufacturing and assembly of 136 units of 41-m-long beams in one of the viaducts has been completed. The manufacturing and assembly re-lated work for the other viaduct are continuing. Nearly half complete, the segment will be done by the end of January 2015.

NEW CONTRACTS

In addition to the ongoing work on the Northern Marmara Highway, Yüksel-Kappa JV has undertaken the manufacturing and assembly of the beams for three new viaducts. With an estimated cost of TRY 3.6 million, the project consists of the manu-facturing of 510 units of 41-m beams. Initiated in December 2014, the project is planned to be com-pleted in March 2015.
